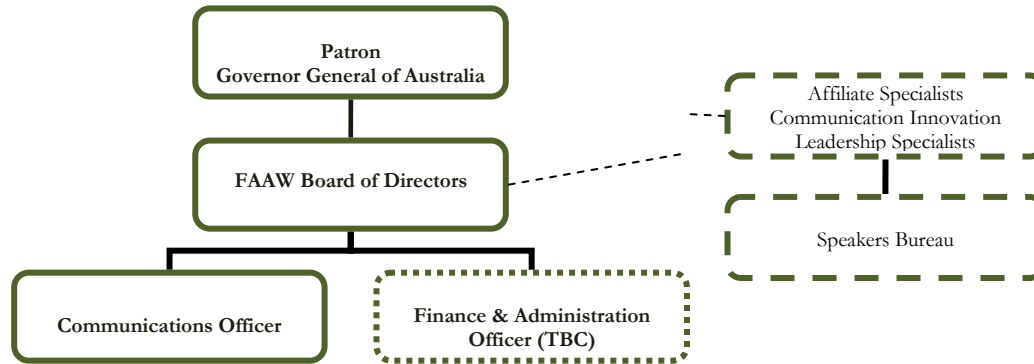
VALUES

The Foundation honours women striving for excellence in their personal and professional lives and values leadership attributes of determination and focus in companionship with:

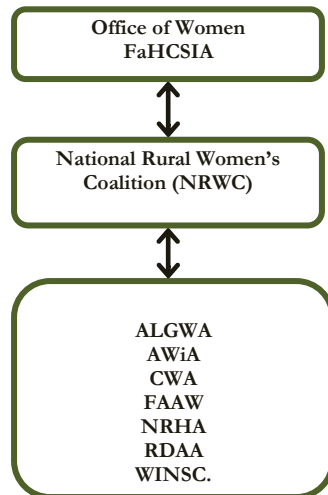
